



## **TUITION AND FEES**

<b>GRADES</b>	<b>ANNUAL TUITION</b>	
<b>Preschool &amp; Kindergarten:</b> Pre-K, Mid-K and K	<b>\$25,200</b>	All supplies are included.
<b>Lower School:</b> grades 1 to 5	<b>\$27,900</b>	Textbooks and Notebooks are included.
<b>Middle School:</b> grades 6 to 8	<b>\$29,450</b>	Textbooks/Media are billed separately.
<b>Upper School:</b> grades 9 and 10	<b>\$34,000</b>	Textbooks/Media are billed separately.
<b>Upper School:</b> grades 11 and 12	<b>\$35,500</b>	Textbooks/Media and Examination Fees are billed separately (PSAT Testing Fee included).

### **MATRICULATION FEE, DEPOSIT AND TUITION PAYMENTS**

**Matriculation Fee** (one-time, non-refundable, not applicable towards tuition): **\$2,000** per new student (**\$1,500** for the second child, and **\$1,000** for any additional children).

**Re-Enrollment Deposit** (non-refundable, applied towards tuition): **\$2,000** per student.

**Tuition Payment Schedule:**

**Option 1:** payment of tuition in full by June 5th.

**Option 2:** payment of tuition in two installments: 60% by June 5th, 40% by November 5th.

**Option 3:** payment of tuition in 10 installments from June 2019 to March 2020; a yearly flat fee of \$50, billed by *TADS*.

**All matriculation fee, deposit and tuition payments must be sent to *TADS*.** Methods of payment accepted: checking/savings account drawn on a U.S. Bank, wire transfer, and credit cards.

## OTHER FEES

- **Application Fee** (non-refundable): **\$50** per child, payable by check drawn on a U.S. Bank, or by credit card on our website. Applications are valid for two years.
- **Textbooks/Media** (grades 6 to 12) and **Examination Fees** (grades 11 and 12): billed separately according to grade, program and options.
  - Estimate of Textbooks/Media Prices:
    - Grades 6-10 & Grades 11-12 French Program only: \$300-\$600 per year
    - Grades 11-12 International Baccalaureate: up to \$1,000 covering two years
  - Estimate of Examination Fees (subject to change):

    - Grade 11 French Program: \$225 registration fee
    - Grade 12 French Program: \$265 registration fee, plus \$200 for the International Option of the Baccalauréat (OIB), plus \$80 per other optional test
    - Grade 12 International Baccalaureate: \$172 registration fee, plus \$119 per subject
- **Hot Lunch Program:** option of 2, 3 or 5 days/week, billed separately, by semester, approximately **\$1,000 to \$1,500/year** for the full week option depending on the grade of the student.
- **Extended Day** (Garderie: Pre-K to grade 5): **\$11.00/hr**
- **Study Hall** (Middle School): **\$15.00/hr**; or annual flat fee: **\$600**
- **Additional Learning Support:** Depending on the recommendations of our Learning Support Department, a fee may apply when the needs of the student require additional services than ordinarily provided.
- **Extracurricular activities and overnight trips organized by the School** are billed upon participation.
- **Private ISB Bus Service** is billed upon participation.
- **ISB Housing Program: \$18,000 – international students staying with host families**  
Room and board with host family, from August 26th to June 30th, supervised by ISB.  
Includes the Hot Lunch Program 5 days/week, one ISB extracurricular activity per trimester, monthly T-passes, College Tour, SAT Prep, yearbook and Orientation Program in August for **new** students entering the IP/IB Programs (*mandatory*).

## ISB FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM / FRENCH GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL AID

Need-based financial aid is available for qualifying families through the **ISB Financial Aid Program**.

Students holding French citizenship and demonstrating a need for financial assistance might qualify for the **Bourses Scolaires Françaises**, allocated by the French government. Also, the ISB Financial Aid Program may supplement the amount granted by the French government. Families are asked to **simultaneously** apply for the *Bourses Scolaires Françaises* and ISB Financial Aid, but the ISB Financial Aid Application will only be reviewed once the family receives the decision from the French government.
